The Business Case for Proactive Compliance

As a global manufacturer, True Manufacturing falls in scope of several product compliance regulations, including the complex EU Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) Regulation. REACH requires manufacturers to engage suppliers and track which chemicals are in their articles.

We figured out what we would need to do to comply with REACH in terms of tasks, expertise, and work hours. We arrived at a crazy number — hundreds of hours. We determined that we would need to outsource a solution. The cost of adding internal resources far outweighed the ROI of going external," recalls James. "We outlined the risk of non-compliance, financial penalties, market access loss, and brand damage versus the cost of compliance. The risks far outweighed the cost of getting a program up and running.

However, a proactive compliance solution wasn't just about saving money. For True Manufacturing, being a sustainability leader is part of their brand value. According to James, "We like to see ourselves as good stewards, and there is 100% a business advantage to that: customer trust and brand reputation. It is always better to lead the charge than be the company dragged across the finish line kicking and screaming."





Aligning Compliance & Legal Needs

The general counsel role is highly involved in True Manufacturing's compliance team, alongside environmental engineering, research and development, procurement, quality engineers, and the director of operations.

A robust compliance program is about more than checking regulatory boxes: "Now, more than ever, almost all our customer contracts contain supply chain clauses that require us to do due diligence. If you don't have a compliance program in place, you might not even be eligible for RFPs," said James. Other legal concerns related to compliance include:

- Penalties paid out to customers
- Lawsuits
- Government sanctions
- Border delays
- Market access loss

By including legal counsel in its compliance program decisions, and sharing supply chain data between teams using Assent's centralized reporting dashboards, True Manufacturing ensures that everyone has the insights needed to prevent disruptions or brand damage.



Measuring the ROI of Proactive Compliance


